The supply chain management and logistics aim responds to customer demands in the best economic conditions in order to fully optimize goods, information and associated financial flows.

The "Pôle d'excellence regional Euralogistic" disseminates and promotes its know-how through the whole Hauts-de-France region towards:

- Companies (logistics operators, freight, industries, distribution, e-business...)
- Harbors and logistics platforms
- Training and research centers
- Local communities, prescribers
- Professional centers and employment stakeholders

The Euralogistic staff proposes fully integrated offers to stakeholders and provides networking between companies, training, and research for structural and innovative projects.

Euralogistic was created in 2003 by the Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Artois network. Since the beginning, Europe, state, regional council, territory and companies support Euralogistic.

Its headquarters is located on the Campus regional Euralogistic, center of excellence near the European multimodal platform DELTA 3 in Dourges. It is located at the crossroads of the second French logistics area, in the core of a 100 millions inhabitant pool around 300kms (between Paris, London and Brussels).

National award winners of logistics innovation in Paris in 2013, DATAR (inter-ministerial delegation dedicated to the territorial planning and to the regional attractiveness) label of remarkable companies cluster, co-founder of French logistics inter-clusters, elected as the European logistics clusters representative inside ALICE (Alliance for Logistics Innovation through Collaboration in Europe) consortium, Euralogistic places as a leader to promote human skills and Hauts-de-France supply-chain and logistics image through a regional and international frame.











The Euralogistic Park

The "Pôle d'excellence regional Euralogistic" owns buildings around 7 hectare. They host tertiary activity companies which benefit from the reach and the image of this unique economic emplacement in France. Euralogistic operates on the whole Hauts-de-France region.

Indeed, beside the A1 highway and the canal, on a railway hub on a European level, are gathered:

- A European tri-multimodal facility (DELTA 3)
- A logistic park with a 600.000 square meters warehouses potential ranked A class
- A multimedia conference room on an industrial emplacement, classified by UNESCO
- A economical campus with training and research activities

The 4 buildings which form the Euralogistic Park, managed by the "Pôle d'Excellence" are dedicated to welcome companies and to hasten the logistic sector development in the region.

The Euralogistic Center 1 (2 platforms with 1200 square meters offices)

The Euralogistic Center 2 (3 platforms with 1400 square meters offices)

The tertiary Center of Euralogistic Campus (3 training platforms with 2200 square meters offices)

The school warehouse of Euralogistic Campus (5000 square meters divided into 3 cells and 800 square meters offices).

This site will extend with the project of "Cité de la Logistique®".

Our training campus

The Euralogistic campus is a unique facility in France which benefits from a great reputation in the logistics field (SITL 2013 Award, Paris – Paris International Transport Logistics Fair). Its first purpose aims to promote qualified working force needs of the regional logistics sector. All in all, it trains around 2500 persons per year, various profiles, until CPC to master level. It is also dedicated to promote and to emphasize jobs and opportunities in the logistics sector.

The Campus hosts a group of training and employment partners with their own activities and premises on the spot.

The Euralogistic Campus is made up of 2 buildings belonging to the Regional Chamber of Commerce and Industry, co-funded by the European Union, by the State, ADEME (environment and energy management agency) and the Hauts-de-France regional council.











An A-class school warehouse of around 5000 square meters and 14 meters high, divided into 3 zones:

- A 1000 square meters cell occupied by a training organization AFTRAL
- A 500 square meters cell dedicated to a showroom of the logistics innovation, a showcase of regional know-how in the equipment and the automation of warehouses.
- A 3500 square meters cell divided into 2 platforms with real logistics flows which allow student to learn in a realistic conditions way

A 2000 square meters tertiary building broadly dedicated to theoretical training with a high using of computing and languages practices.

Outdoor paths allow AFTRAL to ensure the maneuver and docking of articulated vehicles in a safe. This facility aims also to foster the multimodal handling training.

The Euralogistic Campus offers the opportunity to train and to improve future logistics operators to requirements of the modern logistics activities, new technologies and multimodal.

Managed on a 500 square meters surface, within the Campus school warehouse, the showroom of Hauts-de-France logistics innovations remains a showcase enlightening regional know-how in the equipment sector and the warehouse automation: racking, materials handlings, conveyors, software, warehouse management system and so on.

Planned and realized by 15 regional companies, all members of Cluster Euralogistic association (companies cluster, DATAR-approved), this showroom strengthens the place of Hauts-de-France region as a leading logistics area.

All regional companies, involved in warehouse management, abled to work in a cooperative process and abled to develop innovative products, can apply directly to the cluster for joining and exhibiting or testing its innovation within the showroom.

This facility is also used to educate logistics specialist of tomorrow. Business meetings or skill spotting days of logistics candidates are punctually organized.
